AUTOMOTIVE COLLISION REPAIR TECHNICIAN

An Automotive Collision Repair Technician is an individual who repairs, adjusts and replaces sheet metal and associated parts on cars, trucks and buses.

Credential:

The trade is recognized in B.C. and nationally. Individuals who successfully complete the formal apprenticeship requirements of the Program receive the Industry Training Authority Certification of Qualification and receive the Inter-Provincial Red Seal Endorsement upon successful completion of the Red Seal exam.

Duration:

The program usually takes 4 years to complete.

Program Completion Requirements:

Completion of 6750 hours in the workplace and sponsor (employer) attestation.

Successful completion of approximately 15 weeks of in-school technical training.
